Entry requirements

You must be 18 years or over at the start of the course

- Minimum CEFR* A2 or equivalent
- Students applying for a Tier 4 visa must have a minimum CEFR B1/4.0 IELTS or equivalent in each element

Students who apply for this course and do not have an IELTS or equivalent Secured English Language Test (SELT) score (please compare UKVI regulations) will be assessed through our online English Language test.

Students without a SELT can only apply for a Student Visitor visa – the maximum duration for a Student Visitor visa is 11 months.
